



**Clearwater ARPA Social Services and Emergency Housing Fund  
Awarded Grantee Beneficiaries**

Pinellas Community Foundation (PCF) and the City of Clearwater collaborated to distribute American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding to expand emergency housing and social services programming in Clearwater.

The City of Clearwater provided \$1M for two phases of funding. Phase I of this funding provided relocation support to the residents of Capri Mobile Home Park, which was closed in 2023. Phase II funded organizations providing services in Clearwater to support individuals and families with emergency housing and social services needs. Qualifying program areas included:

- Housing
- Food security
- Dental care
- Mental healthcare
- Substance use
- Services for individuals with disabilities
- Aging services and support
- Legal aid
- Youth & families

Eligible 501(c)(3) organizations were those in existence for at least two years at the time of application, providing direct services to residents of Clearwater. The below organizations were awarded after a rigorous due diligence and application assessment period.
