So I left my country and came to U.S. to build a family but we didn't get along.

What you did opened my eyes and gave me hope. You helped me get into my own house, and I'll figure out how to organize my time, get a job, and find daycare.

I love to be a mother and I am so happy with my kids without having someone to control and treat me as a slave.
