We spent \$600 on mental health consultants, for 15 hours of work, \$250 on social workers for 10 hours of work, \$300 on the project director for 20 hours of work, \$1131 on artists for 37.70 hours of work, \$100 on life coach presentations, \$180 on cybersecurity training and compliance (7.2 hours), \$100 on the Financial officer, and \$165 on the medical director consultant. We also spent \$414 on our family bonding activity, \$186 on computer supplies for videotaping presentations, \$2496 on apple computer, and finally \$421 on supplies for the art projects and the family bonding activity.
