Unfortunately at the time, they were put on our waiting due to limited staff. We now serve the residents of Trinity House for our SCP extension. Mr. Johnson is hearing impaired and can text his Essential Shopper to communicate his grocery list and Ms. Daisy who has a speech impairment gets assistance from Ms. Perez in preparing her grocery list and submitting it to her Essential Shopper. Both Mr. Johnson and Ms. Daisy say they are grateful for this service because often, because of their impairments, they are looked over and unable to participate in programs like The Senior Connection Project.
