This family was affected by Covid as both worked in the service industry and lost their jobs in April 2020. The couple had job prospects, but their only income was unemployment. HLA was able to find a two bedroom unit that met all of their needs and was within their budget. After negotiations, the landlord accepted them, due to the upfront move-in costs paid. The family was in their new unit within four days of the referral. The family was appreciative that they were able to avoid getting an eviction on their record, which would have made locating housing challenging. At the time, Joe's fiancé's young son was staying with them, and his own 2 year old son was bouncing around friends' and families' homes with his mother. Joe's son was able to come and live with them in this new, more stable environment. Joe is now back to work, and the little boys are happily sharing a room as brothers!
