**Example:** ABC Charity has only expended \$1,000 this week on program personnel while our food pantry was open. ABC Charity buys its food in bulk on the 15th of every month, and therefore there will be an uptick in expenditure that week.

The Harbor Dish rented a cargo van on Oct. 15 for \$1,328.43 a month. We paid for the first month and a \$200 refundable deposit. We ordered office supplies, including an iPad stand, printer ink and paper, and name badges, for \$515.09. We continued our regular food distribution and began our Take & Bake program in Bayside Church's commercial kitchen. We did a practice run on Oct. 12 for volunteers and Bayside parishioners and cooked for CASA's domestic violence shelter on Oct. 14. For these meals, we used our weekly donations as well as saved dry goods and frozen food from past donations. 360 Eats picked up Tuesday, but they and Feeding the Fosters did not come Wednesday, so we gave the food to Mattie Williams for their Thursday food pantry.
