The Harbor Dish continued its regular food distributions and cooking programs and on March 19 did a dry run to add a meal on Friday nights in the parking lot of a local business, offering samples. The 75 meals are packaged to go, but there are a few tables for those who want to eat there. That meal program began on April 2.

The next time he returned, he met our executive director, Chris, who immediately (and predictably) took him under her wing. She called local restaurants and sent him to one, where he was hired for a dishwashing job. She began gathering clothing for him and looking for a bicycle to fix up. And there was a new member of the Harbor Dish family! Although the Harbor Dish is handling thousands of pounds of food, each client is treated as a valued individual.
