In February, Ronald McDonald House spent \$6,984 on meals, continuing to provide nightly meals for our families in-residence, with leftover meals being distributed throughout the hospital to bedside families. Unfortunately, we were still unsure at this point if we would receive an extension of the CARES funding, so we did not see an uptick this month in food purchases. As an organization, we did make the decision to continue providing transportation for our families, utilizing \$478 on trips within Pinellas County. Also, we had a Pinellas residence that lived too far away from the hospital to travel back-and-forth daily, and we were able to accommodate them with a hotel room for \$792.

Client Story*

At Ronald McDonald House, we have several families with patient cases so severe that they must stay for months at a time to attend to their child. One such family checked into our Central House shortly after it was reopened under our new COVID protocols--this family stayed with us for a total of 250 nights. Mom and Dad faced many challenges during their time at the hospital with their infant, and there were many touch-and-go days where we were unsure the story would have a happy ending. Due to the resources that CARES allowed us to provide this family, they did not have to leave the hospital one time throughout their 8-month stay with us--they had all the meals they could eat provided for them, in a safe and clean environment that allowed them to worry less about their basic needs (and COVID), and concentrate solely on caring for their child. This baby went home healthy, in a matching outfit to her mom who was beaming with immense pride at what her little one had accomplished.
