The Tarpon Springs Shepherd Center has spent \$8,067.44 in payroll expenses for pay periods 10/02/2020 and 10/16/2020 for employees directly affiliated with Pantry & Community Kitchen Assistance. We have allocated additional staff members to assure that quality, timely delivery is top priority. Supply costs were \$771.82 - food bags, cutlery, aluminum foil, storage bags, and hinged trays. Utilities/recycling expense \$993.41- both the cardboard recycling and our utilities (Duke Energy) have increased substantially. Capitol purchase of the large freezer has been paid for a total reimbursement for \$13,000.00. We continue to see an increase in individuals needing food and hot meals, as the holiday approaches we predict this trend will continue
